


## Honeywell Thermostat Configuration

The first step is to authorize the INSOMNIAC IoE Control Center to access the Honeywell Thermostats. This must be done either as an STC or Account Administrator user. You need to have your Honeywell account log on information to complete these steps.

1. Select Account Admin/Honeywell Lyric




2. Select Add Lyric Integration. Give the Lyric an Integration Name.



3. Select the Authorize button. This will take you to the Lyric Honeywell web page.





- 6. The user will then be returned to the INSOMNIAC IoE portal. All of the Thermostats selected should be displayed.


