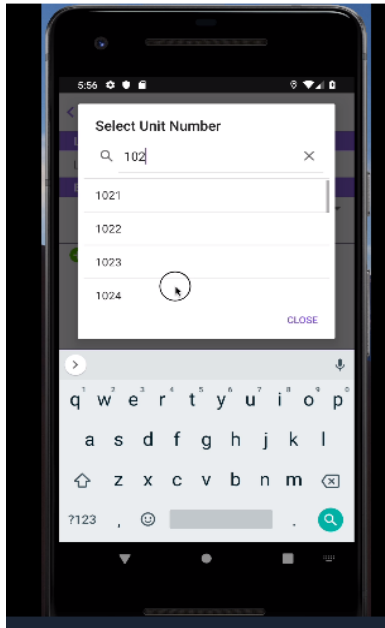


SG-71 (Storage Genie Unit Number Search Field)

The Android version of Storage Genie now includes a searchable spinner control for the unit number where users can enter their unit number. Previously, when on the Pixel and other Android devices (all Android versions), the Unit Number search field was not present. Users had to scroll through a list to find their unit number.

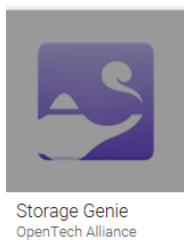


SG-75 (Storage Genie Compatibility with Android Pie on Google Pixel Smartphone)

The Storage Genie app now fully supports the Android 8 Oreo and 9 Pie mobile operating systems that includes the Google Pixel 2 and 3 smartphones. *If automatic application update is not enabled, the user should download the latest version of the Storage Genie app from the Google Play Store.*

SG-76 (Storage Genie App Launcher Icon)

SG-77 (Google Play Application Permissions)

In prior Android releases, Storage Genie was direct dialing from the app to the self-storage facility. Google requires special permission to access SMS and call log information on a user's device, and so this functionality was removed at this time. When the user taps the "Call" button, the Storage Genie app will now bring up a dial pad with the associated number where the user can tap the button to initiate a call.

SG-78 (Miscellaneous Issues)

The following additional Storage Genie issues were addressed as part of v1.0.3.240:

- Facilities – Fixed the facilities not loading
- Welcome Note - Fixed the welcome note text not being shown on some devices
- Cancelable Process Dialogue - Disable the cancelable option for the progress dialogs
- Warnings – Fixed compiler warnings
