


### SG-55 (Storage Genie Non-Tenant Access)

---

Prior to this new release, the Storage Genie app was restricted to tenants with rented units to gain access to their self-storage facility. Storage Genie is now extended to allow a non-tenant or guest to use the app to enter even though they do not have a rented unit at the facility. To enable Non-Tenant access select the Non-Tenant selector. The non-tenant or guest is required to enter their Last Name and Entry Code. There is no entry needed for Unit number. Storage Genie history logs all tenant user attempts in accessing the self-storage facility in the OpenTech IoE Control Center. However, history is not available in the Storage Genie app for Non-Tenants.



### SG-88 (Storage Genie E-Mail Text)

---

The following text was added to the body of all e-mail messages sent from the Storage Genie app to a tenant:


- Facility Name
- Unit Number
- Tenant Last Name

Note: For a non-tenants or guests, the e-mail would include Facility Name and Last Name. Unit Number will show as Units(s) N/A.

### SG-91 (Disable Storage Genie Auto Open)

---

Self-storage property managers now have the option of turning off the Storage Genie Auto Open feature for their facility via a configurable setting in the OpenTech IoE Control Center. The Auto Open feature allows a tenant, non-tenant or guest "hands-free" access to their facility without requiring the user to open the Storage Genie app. If Auto Open is disabled, the setting is grayed out in the Storage Genie app. If Auto Open is disabled in the OpenTech IoE Control Center the tenant, non-tenant or guest would be required to open the Storage Genie app and press the OPEN button that should be green if within range of the facility gate.



### SG-94 (Storage Genie Support for International Phone Numbers)

---

The Storage Genie "Call" feature now supports self-storage facilities with international phone numbers. International phone numbers are formatted in accordance with their respective standards starting with the country code.
